## Brevard Public Schools Meal Distribution

Free meals are given to children 18 years and younger Monday-Friday at schools throughout the county.

### **The Children's Hunger Project Meal Distribution**

The Children's Hunger Project has teamed up with Brevard Public Schools to provide students with weekend meals.

### **Senior Shopping Hours**

A variety of stores are opening their stores early for senior shopping only. BJ's Wholesale Club is also opening up their stores early for senior shoppers from 8:00am-9:00am.

### **South Brevard Sharing Center**

### **Space Coast Area Transit Free Fares**

321 Transit is offering free rides for everyone and allowing riders to enter and exit through the back door of the bus to create social distancing.

### **AdventHealth Telemedicine Free E-Care (Volusia County)**

Free e-care visits up to a certain amount are allocated for all Volusia County Schools families. This is helpful if you don't want to take your sick child into the ER, walk-in clinic, or doctor's office.

### **Florida Small Business Emergency Bridge Loan**

This loan is designed to get Florida small businesses funds quickly so they can keep their doors open during a crisis.

### **U.S. SBA Economic Injury Disaster Loans**

This nationwide loan is for businesses who have suffered substantial economic loss from COVID-19. It provides capital for businesses to stay above water until normal operations begin again.

### **SBA Payment Protection Program**

This program provides small businesses with 8 weeks of cash-flow for things such as payroll costs, mortgage interest, utilities.

### **FPL COVID-19 Resources**

FPL is currently suspending disconnections, waiving certain late fees, and providing payment extensions for those experiencing financial hardship.

### **Duke Energy COVID-19 Resources**

Duke Energy isn't disconnecting service for non-payment. They're providing customers extra time to make payments.

### **Spectrum Internet**

Spectrum is partnering with school districts to help Pre-K to 12 & college student along with teachers learn remotely by offering free Wi-Fi & broadband. To enroll in the program, call 1-844-488-8395. Installation fees will be waived for new student households.

### **AT&T COVID-19**

AT&T will not disconnect any wireless, home phone, or broadband service for lack of payment along with keeping public Wi-Fi hotspots open. They will also waive late fees and domestic wireless plan overages.

### **Uber**

Uber is offering financial assistance to their drivers & deliverers who have been diagnosed with COVID-19 or put in isolation by a public health authority.
